


I. Identity

Conditions: 400 MHz, DMSO-d₆


The structure is confirmed with the signals of the spectrum and their interpretation








lb. Mass Spectrum

318	[M – Br]


The signals of the mass spectrum and their interpretation are consistent with the structural formula.

II. Purity


The purity of the reference substance was analysed by high performance liquid chromatography (HPLC).

HPLC Conditions:

Conditions: Column: **Detector:** Injector: Purospher RP-18 e 1.0 ml/min, 40 °C DAD Auto 5 µm, 125 x 4 mm 0-15 min Water/Acetonitrile 75/25 220 nm 15 µl; 0.037 mg/ml in 15-20 min Water/Acetonitrile to 50/50 Water/Acetonitrile 50/50 (v/v) 20-25 min Water/Acetonitrile 50/50 25-30 min Water/Acetonitrile to 75/25 30-40 min Water/Acetonitrile 75/25 (v/v); 0.1 % H₃PO₄

For the calculation the bromide peak and the system peaks were ignored. The content of the analyte was determined as ratio of the peak area of the analyte and the cumulative areas of the purities, added up to 100 %.

No significant amounts of residual solvents were detected (< 0.05 %).

V. Final Result
